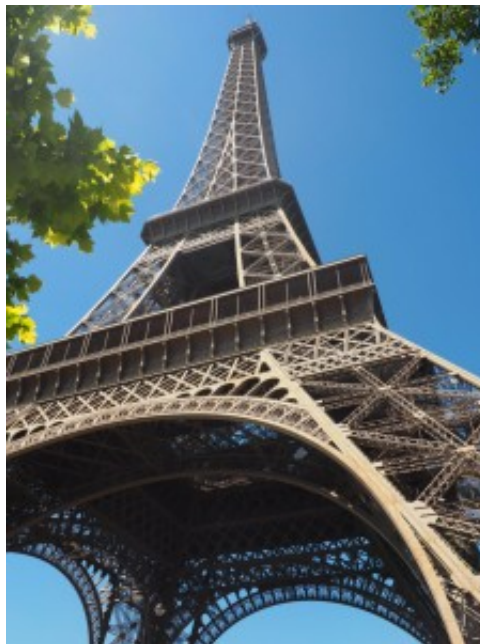
Hamburg
